All families that choose services through Community Partnerships of Idaho have the option of attending a Family Partnerships Meeting. This allows you to decide and prepare for the services, described below, within your child's annual budget that will best meet the needs of your family.


Community Partnerships provides relationship-focused services. We match our staff with community partners and you to help achieve your goals. Since 1995, our long-term partnerships have resulted in families having a high level of satisfaction with services.

Family Education

We provide general training in behavior modification, crisis intervention, specific disabilities, potty training, sensory needs, and much more. Family Education classes are offered for those who prefer to learn with other parents.

Respite

Designed so that caregivers can receive a needed break, respite is quality, activity-based child care provided by

a trained staff member in your home, our center or at our child care facility, SandCastles Learning Center in Boise near Ustick and Cole Roads. Services can be one on one or provided to a group of children.

Habilitative Supports

Does your child need support to attend community activities, such as 4-H, team sports, Boy/Girl Scouts, clubs, church, or volunteering? This innovative, community-focused service is the answer.

It can be used to involve your child in his or her community to help develop friendships and relationships with others. Services are provided by a Habilitative Support Technician that completes training required by the State of Idaho.

Habilitative Intervention

Do you need help managing your child's behaviors? Habilitative Intervention is a highly individualized service provided directly to your child to decrease challenging behaviors, and increase skills in communication, socialization, and play.

Our professionals are certified by the State of Idaho and trained in evidence based practices, including Applied Behavioral Analysis, Positive Behavior Supports, Discrete Trial Training, and others. Families receiving this service are required to participate in Family Training.

Family Training

You need skills to get through every day, real life moments. Family Training is direct instruction provided to the family by a certified professional, in the presence of the child, to teach skills necessary to maximize learning and decrease challenging behaviors. Our professional staff will help your family learn the skills necessary to achieve your goals. This service is required when you are receiving Habilitative Intervention.

Interdisciplinary Training

This service allows your Habilitative Interventionist time to instruct the staff providing Support and Respite for your child. This cost effective service helps to equip and train staff, plus facilitates consistency among service providers. *A child must be present for this training.*

Therapeutic Consultation

Consultation by professionals with Masters-level certification and advanced training is available to prevent a crisis situation. A Therapeutic Consultant performs specialized assessments and advises the Habilitative Interventionist, the family and other service providers with more effective methods to implement Positive Behavioral Supports. *Your child may access up to 18 hours of this service per year.*

Crisis Intervention

Crisis intervention is emergency back-up and training for a child experiencing or is expected to experience a crisis. A Masters-level professional oversees crisis intervention services provided by professionals and para-professionals. *Your child may not access this service for more than 30 consecutive days.*
