EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

HELPING INDIVIDUALS MEET THEIR GOALS



The Employment Services Department at Community Partnerships of Idaho serves individuals of working age.

Services are individualized and provided by our professional staff to assist individuals in reaching their vocational goal leading to long term employment success.

Program Funding

Services are provided in conjunction with the Idaho Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, the Idaho Commission for the Blind & Visually Impaired, Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, Montana State University (WIPA), and employers throughout Idaho. Consumer Direct Services and Private Pay are also funding options.

Pre-Employment Transition Services

This service is geared towards high school students (ages 16-21) with disabilities. Students who participate in employment activities while in high school have more employment success following graduation. Services include: Youth Extended Services, Counseling, Job Exploration, Job Shadowing, Work Based Learning opportunities, Work Readiness Training, Soft Skill Development, Self Advocacy Training and summer employment opportunities.

AVAILABLE SERVICES

Customized Employment Services

This service provides flexibility and is personalized to meet the need of the employment relationship (employer/employee). Services are defined through a process of identifying the strengths, conditions, and interests of a job candidate or employee through a process of discovery. It may include job search assistance, job carving, self-employment, or other job restructuring strategies that lead to desired vocational goals.

Assessment: Vocational Evaluation

Vocational Evaluation services utilize interest, academic, and aptitude testing to help identify realistic vocational goals and matches interests with skills to assist with finding the right job.

Job Search Assistance

Our professional employment staff provides individualized job search assistance that leads to success in meeting their vocational goals in employment. Services include: assistance in completing and learning how to complete applications, resumes and cover letters. Assistance in learning how to talk to employers and schedule interviews. Assistance in preparing for and attending interview that lead to employment.

Short Term Job Supports

This is time limited support to assist individuals in learning the job and meeting employer expectations. We work closely with the employer and new employee to ensure long term success.

Supported Employment Job Coaching

For individuals that need extended or long term supports on site supported job coaching services are available.

Work Incentives Planning and Assistance

This service is a Social Security funded program that provides benefits counseling to Social Security Disability beneficiaries who are working or interested in going to work. When you're ready to explore work options contact the ticket to work helpline: 866-968-7842.
