What are Adult Day Services?

Community Partnerships Adult Day Services provides supervised activities for adults with developmental disabilities to learn new skills, develop friendships, spend time socializing with friends and have fun! Adult Day Services are provided in a group setting and are meant to increase socialization skills. Services are provided in the center, and on occasion, the group may participate in community activities. Adult Day Services are a Medicaid reimbursed program.

What Are The Hours for Adult Day Services?

Hours are set by each office providing this service. Please contact our office nearest you for more information.

How Do I get Started?

Contact your Targeted Service Coordinator (TSC) and tell them you would like Adult Day Services added to your Individual Support Plan (ISP).

How Do I Know What Activities Are Planned?

A calendar of daily activities is created each month and is packed full of fun activities like cooking, crafts, karaoke, parties, art competitions, "sweatin' to the oldies," movies and more! Please contact our office nearest you and we'll mail or email the calendar to you.

How Much Does it Cost?

Some activities will have a cost and the amount for each is listed on the monthly calendar.

If I'm Not on the Waiver, Can I Pay Privately?

Yes, private pay is accepted and can be set up at your request.

Does Adult Day Services Come Out of My Budget?

Yes, this service is put on your ISP and is part of your budget.

Can Parents/Providers Assist With Adult Day Services?

We encourage parents/providers to assist with demonstrations and/or teaching new skills. If you have an interest please let us know you would like to volunteer.
