



Frequently Asked Questions

What are Employment Services at Community Partnerships?

Employment Services assist job seekers in preparing for, obtaining and maintaining employment. The following are some of our services:

- Vocational Evaluations: Interest and aptitude testing is helpful if you are making a career change or if you have never worked.
- Job Site Development assists in you in preparing for and finding employment. This includes: Completing applications/resumes/cover letters; Interview preparations; Marketing **you** to employers in the community; and Scheduling interviews.
- On the Job Training or Support: Assists you in succeeding and maintaining employment (job coaching, work adjustment, follow along) as well as negotiating reasonable accommodations.
- Community Based Work Evaluations: Determines if you are employment ready. These evaluations are done with local employers and work sites throughout the community.
- Skills Training: Job club/trainings and group classes give you hands-on training to become employment ready.

Who pays for the services and supports I need?

Job Seeking Support is funded traditionally by the Idaho Department of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Idaho Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired.

We also accept funding through private rehabilitation, Work Comp claims, private pay, SSI Ticket to Work, and Self Direction. We also work with Veterans through the US Department of Veterans Affairs VR&E.

Once employed, we can provide you with on-the-job support. This is typically paid for through the funding agency.

Job Coaching Support and Long term Community Supported Employment is funded through Medicaid, Self Direction, Idaho Department of Vocational Rehabilitation’s Extended Employment Services. Private pay is also accepted.

How does someone qualify for Employment Services?

Eligibility for employment services is usually determined by the funding agency. Community Partnerships can assist you in starting the employment process. In addition, Community Partnerships serves individuals paying privately.

Why should I choose Community Partnerships?

Community Partnerships has highly skilled and trained staff with strong relationships in our community to assist you in finding and maintaining employment. We are known as the “go to” agency for getting people employed. We work with all types of job seekers from entry level to highly skilled.
