HABILITATION INTERVENTION SERVICES

HABILITATIVE SKILL

This direct intervention service includes techniques used to develop, improve and maintain to the maximum extent possible, the developmentally appropriate functional abilities and daily living skills needed by and individual

BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION

This service utilizes direct intervention techniques used to produce positive meaningful changes in behavior that incorporate functional replacement behaviors and reinforcement strategies.

CRISIS INTERVENTION

This service may include providing training to staff directly involved with the participant, delivering emergency backup intervention and developing a crisis plan that directly addresses the behavior occurring and the necessary intervention strategies to minimize the behavior and future occurrences.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TRAINING

This is a companion service to behavioral intervention and habilitative skill and is used to assist with implementing a participant's health and medication monitoring, positioning and physical transferring, use of assistive equipment, and intervention techniques in a manner that meets the participant's needs.

SUPPORT SERVICES

COMMUNITY BASED SUPPORTS

This service provides children an opportunity to explore their interests, improve their skills through community participation and integration and provides opportunities to practice skills learned in other therapeutic and natural environments.

FAMILY EDUCATION

Family Education is assistance to families to meet their child's needs. It is delivered by a professional to orient family and caregivers to the child's developmental disability and general strategies and techniques to utilize with the child's specific diagnosis.

RESPITE SERVICES

Respite is designed so that caregivers can receive a needed break. Respite at RISE is quality, activity based child care provided by trained staff. Group respite is offered specifically to each office location.

BRIGHT BEGINNINGS

Bright Beginning's is an Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) based program for children with developmental disabilities. ABA is a scientifically proven intervention approach that uses principles that increase skills and decrease challenging behavior by using positive reinforcement strategies.

This uniquely structured program is for children diagnosed with a developmental disability age 3 through 6.

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
